3. At the pool by the Sheep Gate, there was a man waiting to be healed. Jesus saw him and knew that he had already been in that condition for a long time. Jesus asked him what he wanted. The man said that he had no man to put him into the pool to be healed before others went in. How long did John say the man had an infirmity?
