1. In chapter 6, John records that Jesus went over the Sea of Galilee – which is what sea according to John?
2. After Jesus crossed the Sea of Galilee; a great multitude followed him, because they saw the signs that He performed on those who were diseased. John records that Jesus fed this great multitude – How many men does John record in chapter 6 eat while seated on the mountain with Jesus?
3. During the feeding of the multitude, as recorded in Chapter, six how many fish did the lad have that was blessed and used by Jesus to feed the multitude?
4. During the feeding of the multitude, as recorded in Chapter six, how many loaves of bread did the lad have that was blessed and used by Jesus to feed the multitude?
